The Alarm Company Operator DRC is authorized to hear appeals of alarm company operators, alarm company qualified managers, alarm agents, or firearm permit holders, licensed, certified, or registered by the Bureau under Chapter 11.6 (commencing with Section 7590 of the Business and Professions Code).

The purpose of the Private Investigator Disciplinary Review Committee (DRC) is to review applicants' appeals of the Bureau's denials of licensure and licensees' appeals of the Bureau's suspensions and imposition of fines. The Private Investigator DRC is authorized to hear appeals of private investigators, or firearm permit holders, licensed, certified, or registered by the Bureau under Chapter 11.3 (commencing with Section 7512 of the Business and Professions Code).

Alarm Company Operator, Private Investigator, and Collateral Recovery Disciplinary Review Committees
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The purpose of the Collateral Recovery Disciplinary Review Committee (DRC) is to review applicants' appeals of the Bureau's denials of licensure and licensees' appeals of the Bureau's suspensions and imposition of fines. The Collateral Recovery DRC is authorized to hear appeals of repossession agencies, repossession agency qualified managers, or repossession agency employees, licensed, certified, or registered by the Bureau under Chapter 11 (commencing with Section 7500 of the Business and Professions Code).

Purpose of Joint Meeting: This joint meeting of the Alarm Company Operator, Private Investigator, and Collateral Recovery Disciplinary Review Committees is being held for the purpose of providing regular and ongoing training to DRC members. Bureau of Security and Investigative Services management and counsel will provide instruction on the topics identified in Item 3 of this agenda.
