14	WHEREAS, the STATE OF OREGON, Board of Investigators, and the				
15	STATE OF CALIFORNIA, Bureau of Security & Investigative Services				
16	(herein "Parties") desire to enter an agreement for the granting				
17	of a limited reciprocal licensure exemption for the mutual				
18	benefit of their citizens.				
19					
20	WHEREAS, each Party's education, examination and/or experience				
21	requirements for the licensing and registration of LICENSED				
22	INVESTIGATORS are satisfactory to the other Party as applicable				
23	to their respective statutes.				
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NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed that a resident of OREGON or

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- 3 CALIFORNIA who is currently licensed to practice as an
- 4 investigator may be granted a limited reciprocal licensure
- 5 exemption from the licensing requirements of the reciprocal
- 6 state. The exemption is only available to:

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- 8 2.1 Investigators who are licensed by the reciprocating state
- 9 and whose license is in good standing with the
- reciprocating state.

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- 12 2.2 Investigators, qualified per Paragraph 2.1 above, who enter
- the reciprocating state to conduct investigations only if
- the investigation originated in their home state.
- Furthermore, investigation in the reciprocating state is
- limited to sixty (60) days per investigator per case.
- 17 Investigations exceeding sixty (60) days must be handled by
- a licensed investigator in the reciprocating state. The
- exemption does not authorize investigators to solicit
- investigative business in the reciprocating state or to
- conduct investigative business in the reciprocating state
- other than as specifically stated in this paragraph.

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2	FURTHERMORE,	the	parties	agree	that
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4 3.1 Any complaint or disciplinary action sought against 5 the investigator arising out of the licensee's 6 investigative activities in the reciprocating state 7 shall be forwarded to the administrator of the 8 investigative regulatory agency in the state which 9 granted the license. The licensing agency, which 10 granted the investigator license, shall possess all 11 responsibility for administering such complaints and 12 disciplinary action, if proposed, according to that 13 state's statutes. In the case of dual licensure, a 14 complaint against an investigator shall be 15 administered by the state within which the 16 investigation case originated.

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3.2 This agreement may be terminated by either party upon thirty(30) days written notice.

WHEREAS, the legal authority to enter into this agreement is

- 3 conferred upon the parties by their respective state's statutes,
- 4 found in OREGON REVISED STATUTES 703.440 and in CALIFORNIA
- 5 STATUTES section 7520.5 of the California Business & Professions
- 6 Code.
